BRETT'S TWO-CENTS

Hello, everyone! Last week we looked at the difference between the Catholic and Protestant canons (or list of books) of the Bible, and saw that Catholic Old Testaments contain seven more books (the “deuterocanonical books” or “apocrypha”) than do Protestant Old Testaments. This week we look at a related question: what are these “Gnostic gospels” that one occasionally hears about these days? Are they (as the authors of such works as *The DaVinci Code*, etc.) a set of secret, rival scriptures that the Church tried to suppress because it feared their message as too liberal, even dangerous?

Hardly. Scripture scholars and theologians have known about the Gnostic texts (e.g., *the Gospel of Thomas*, *the Gospel of Mary Magdalene*, etc.) all along. The reason they are not well-known among your average Christian is not because the Church tried to suppress them out of fear, but rather because they’re not very good as Scripture. Gnosticism was a rival religious movement to Christianity in the first 3 or 4 centuries of the Church’s life, but it was rather a mish-mash as religious faiths go. It drew on Christian, Jewish, Greek, Syrian, Mesopotamian, Egyptian, and Persian sources, often simultaneously. Far from being open-minded or egalitarian, however, the Gnostics believed that salvation was only for an elite few. They considered the material world to be an evil prison, the creation of an evil god (often identified with the God of the Old Testament). From this prison, only a special few would ever escape. If you were a woman, you could pretty much give up all hope: the *Gospel of Thomas*, for instance, states that women are inherently unworthy of the Kingdom. In general, the Gnostic texts are

“characterized by their dreadfully elaborate mythologies, which abound in invention, but not in imagination. And much of that literature is marred by a streak of adolescent cruelty. In the Second Treatise of the Great Seth, for instance, Christ tells how he deceived the powers of this world by causing Simon the Cyrene to take on his appearance, and thus to be crucified in his place, while he watched from above, laughing at the stupidity of the ‘archons.’

*Gnosticism spoke to a particular sort of spiritual discontent among persons of a certain type of temperament. It was not, however, a message of hope for a suffering humanity.” (David Hart, *The Story of Christianity*)*

Thus, the reason that the Gnostic texts never survived the test of time is the same reason that not every novel that’s written becomes a classic: most don’t possess the beauty, power, and grasp of truth necessary to speak to generation after generation, culture upon culture.
