### GREETINGS FROM FR. BILL

As many of you may know, the dioceses and parishes in the United States are in the midst of a three-year Eucharistic Revival. This was originally initiated in response to the 2019 PEW study (bit.ly/PEW-Eucharist19) which inaccurately claimed that only 1/3 of Catholics believe in the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist. In October 2023, a newer and more accurate study, called the CARA Report (bit.ly/CARA-Eucharist23), was released which focused its attention on this issue and found that 95% of Catholics who attend Mass weekly believe in the Real Presence. When taking into account Catholics who don't attend Mass, the overall data showed that 2/3 of Catholics believe in the Eucharist. 1/3 vs. 2/3 is a statistically significant difference!

I remind us of this information as it has readjusted how we will be preaching at the weekend Mass this coming Advent. Archbishop Sample asked all of us priests to preach about the Eucharist, but instead of trying to convince you, who are in the pews, about the Real Presence, we will now be preaching about how, given that we are Eucharistic people, we can "Go" out and put into action the great mystery we proclaim and have received at Mass. Notice the "Go" part? Yes, this means we will be focusing on the third part of our mission (Know, Grow, Go). Our hope is that we can inspire and give you tools from which you can share your love of Christ in the Eucharist to those Catholics who are not attending Mass regularly. Regularly = every weekend. The weekend themes for the weekend Masses are tentatively set for the following: Love/Sacrifice, Healing, Communion, and Reverence.

Finally, I want to offer you encouragement to attend the coming weekend's big "Healing the Whole Person" retreat, which will bring several national speakers and experts on the topic of healing. Let's face it, we are all broken in some way. And we often pick at these issues and try to fix them. Yet, our attempts fall short and we continue to live our of our wounds. Imagine being set free of them. This is the goal of this multiple day seminar.

Without getting into the details, attendees will be encouraged to seek out the roots of their wounds and ask the Holy Spirit to heal them. It is only when we can get to the roots of what created and continues to feed our brokenness that we can be set free and be given a new lease on life. Is this claim overdone? I don't think so. I know for myself, this group has helped me tremendously, and I want you to experience the healing only possible by God.


