As we've begun replacing components, we've discovered previouslyhidden problems that are now causing sound drop-outs, particularly for those of you sitting up in the "wings" of the nave. Hopefully we're getting those sorted. We know how frustrating it is to come to Mass and not be able to hear clearly. Please know that we ARE working on the situation.

Hail Mary, full of grace! Mary, do we know how marvelous you are, holy and full of grace? That because of your 'yes' to God's invitation to be the mother of His son ("Behold, I am the handmaid of the Lord. May it be done to me according to your word." (Lk 1:38)), all that we celebrate now is possible?

You and Jesus were a part of God's plan of rescue for humanity since that awful moment in the garden with the serpent ("I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your seed and her seed." (Gn 3:15)). You are the New Eve and the "mother of all the living" (Gn 3:20). You are "the mother of [our] Lord" (Lk 1:43), the image of perfect trust in God and Advent waiting.

December 12: Feast Day of Our Lady of Guadalupe

"Our Lady of Guadalupe has been honored by twenty-five popes. She has been formally declared Patroness and Mother of the Americas. Informally, she is honored as Patroness of Unborn Children because she appeared to Juan Diego as a pregnant woman and, in the seven years after the apparitions, approximately eight million Aztec people converted to Catholicism, and abandoned a culture of death that had practiced human sacrifice, including infant sacrifice. May we, through the

intercession of Our Lady of Guadalupe, see an end to the killing of vulnerable people in our own day, whether through abortion, euthanasia, or neglect of their basic human needs."
