Hello everyone! I hope by now you've all been able to take apart your arks and store them until our next deluge. Wouldn't it be nice if all the precipitation we've been getting would get with the program and turn into some honest-to-goodness snow?

Speaking of which, as we move into the winter season, a reminder that we will always have Masses here at church (barring something truly unforeseen!). Fr. Bill and Fr. Anthony are only a few blocks away and can make it here on foot even if driving is impossible. Fr. Bill has even been training Snickers to pull a sled. Or maybe it's the other way around? In any case, just because we're having Mass doesn't mean you should venture out. Please use good judgment as to road conditions and your ability to make it here safely. Among other considerations, our ability to remove snow and ice from the parking lots is limited, and we don't want anyone falling between their car and the church. If conditions are dangerous, there's no obligation to come to Mass.

A second housekeeping item: All of us have our favorite donuts downstairs at Coffee & Donuts (*btw, whatever happened to those blueberry-filled, crunchy-*

*topped creations? Hmmm???*). HOWEVER, if you do not find your favorite set out on the table, please don't go looking for it back in the kitchen (*yes, yes, myself included!*). Our donut crew tries to carefully set aside enough donuts for each Mass; when folks start taking from the "reserved" donuts, there isn't enough for later Masses. Thanks for your help with this.

Finally, a huge 'thank you' for your patience as we continue to work out the bugs in our sound system. The plan is to eventually replace the speakers for the center part of the nave with line-arrays, which should dramatically improve the sound, and to refurbish the surround speakers mounted to the large glue-lam beams around the perimeter. As we've begun replacing components, we've discovered previously-hidden problems that are now causing sound drop-outs, particularly for those of you sitting up in the "wings" of the nave. Hopefully we're getting those sorted. We know how frustrating it is to come to Mass and not be able to hear clearly. Please know that we ARE working on the situation.

*Hail Mary, full of grace!* Mary, do we know how marvelous you are, holy and full of grace? That because of your 'yes' to God's invitation to be the mother of His son ("*Behold, I am the handmaid of the Lord. May it be done to me according to your word.*" (Lk 1:38)), all that we celebrate now is possible?

You and Jesus were a part of God's plan of rescue for humanity since that awful moment in the garden with the serpent ("*I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your seed and her seed.*" (Gn 3:15)). 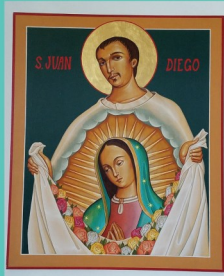
