GREETINGS FROM FR. BILL

Gaudete Sunday! The word (pronounced gow-DAY-tay), is Latin for "rejoice." It worship, so Christmas is like our Superbowl! When comes from the introit, or entrance antiphon, of the you come to Mass, be mindful that we'll have many Mass of this day. This weekend, the Church wants us visitors, including folks who have been away or are at to have a momentary sense of gladness and rejoicing Mass for the first time. With the increasing number as we round "third base" of our Advent season, also signified in the rose-colored candle lit in our Advent opportunity for us to show our love for Jesus and wreath and our rose-colored vestments.

There is a parallel Sunday in Lent (its fourth Sunday, since there are five total in Lent), entitled Laetare Sunday (pronounced leh-TAR-ee), which also translates as "rejoice." Often not understood, Advent is a penitential season akin to Lent. Since Advent is sprinkled with a greater sense of hope, the violet or purple used in these two seasons are sometime distinguished by different hues.

Turning our attention to next weekend, the Fourth Sunday of Advent and Christmas practically land on top of each other! So, I want to avoid confusion and be as clear as possible with our Mass schedule:

- Weekend Masses for 4th Sunday of Advent are Saturday at 5:30pm & Sunday at 8:00 & 9:30am.
- We will *not* have our 11:15am Mass next Sunday.
- Christmas Eve Masses are later in the day at 4:00, 6:00, and 8:00pm. Only the 4:00pm Mass will be live streamed.
- Christmas Day Mass is at 9:00am.

Both the 4th Sunday of Advent (Saturday evening or Sunday morning) and Christmas (Sunday evening or Monday morning) are Holy Days of Obligation. So, you "have" to go to Mass twice over those three days - once for Advent Week 4 and once for Funeral services are scheduled for Dan O'Leary next Christmas. And yes, you would receive Communion at each Mass, even if both are on the same day.

gaudete Sunday is our "game day" when we come to Mass for of non-church goers, Christmas is the greatest how glad we are to have them join us in worship by our actions and being the most excellent of hosts.

> Everyone has their preferred parking places and pews, but it would be very off-putting to folks if we cut them off in the parking lot or began to reserve seats. For some, it will only take one small bump in their plans for them to turn around and go home. Consider parking farther away than you normally do. Assume someone else will be sitting where you normally sit. Make an extra effort to greet those around you, especially those whom you do not know. Christmas is important to everyone, so please put forward your best attitude of patience. I know you all to be so kind and loving, but even the best of us can get snarly when things aren't how we expected.

> Our sacrificial love is what our visitors need to encounter! Who knows what wounds, baggage, or hesitations they will bring when they come to church. Make it your goal to meet someone new and show them how gracious we are as a parish community. We want them to encounter our Lord in the short time they will be with us and to consider coming again. You will be Jesus' presence to them. Simply be the wonderful, generous parishioners that you are, mindful that joy begets more joy!

It's GAUDETE SUNDAY! We're now more than halfway through Advent, and Gaudete Sunday marks this point, telling us to hold on, we are almost there! We see a rose color candle lit in our Advent wreath. Gaudete means REJOICE! Everything the Church does to prepare us is always to make us holier versions of ourselves, more aligned to the way that Christ calls us to be. Our praying this Advent allows God to transform us to more closely be someone who is holy, watchful, patiently waiting for the Christ our heart yearns for. And we wait "in joyful hope" for a glimpse of Heaven. Today's Second Reading (1 Thes 5:16-24) gives us a roadmap:

"Rejoice always. Pray without ceasing. In all circumstances give thanks, for this is the will of God for you in Christ Jesus. Do not quench the Spirit. Do not despise prophetic utterances. Test everything; retain what is good. Refrain from every kind of evil.

"May the God of peace make you perfectly holy and may you entirely, spirit, soul, and body, be preserved blameless for the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ. The one who calls you is faithful, and he will also accomplish it."

Let's do as St. Paul says. Show our kindness to everyone. Remember that Jesus is already right here in our midst, so there is nothing to be afraid of. Talk to God with our thankful prayers, expecting God's grace and peace, guiding our minds and hearts. What are we grateful for, sorry about, asking Jesus for? Tell Jesus in our prayer this *Gaudete Sunday*. +



"Eating locusts and grasshoppers, wearing camel skins, preaching repentance, living in a desert among wild animals, and facing a gruesome death aren't images that provoke joy. Yet today's readings, connect John the Baptist to. . . advent joy, which asks us to step back and reflect on a different path to rejoicing. . .

"[Gill's] predicament could have made him ask: how can there be joy in a world so full of violence? Yet, despite everything, he is filled with joy, imbuing a well -ripened truth: 'It is not joy that makes us grateful, it is gratitude that gives us joy' (Benedictine monk David Steindl-Rast)."

Reflect: How is God calling you into a deeper experience of giving and gratitude during this season?


