Hello, everyone! Boy, I'm gone for a weekend and everything changes — I'm now the parent of a college graduate, our Marian garden is totally revamped (more on that in a moment), and we once again have air conditioning in the church! Sorry about last weekend; I'm glad it was at least somewhat cooler than it had been earlier in the week.



If you haven't taken a look already, be sure to visit our beautiful Marian garden between the School and Church entrances. HT graduate and parishioner Jack Ryan coordinated the much-needed task of renovating the area as his Eagle Scout Service Project. Jack coordinated with us on appropriate plants and necessary supplies, organized a crew, and led the effort last Saturday to transform the garden.



The top photo to the left here is the "before" shot. Just to give you an idea of what all Jack and his crew did: the azalea and rhododendrons were unfortunately severely diseased, so they were removed along with several other bushes. Hebe, sedum, and lavender bushes were planted along with a few hydrangeas, as well as several clusters of gladiolus and dahlias that will come up next spring. Mary was moved and is once again gleaming under a new arbor that will eventually have roses climbing around it. The existing clematis was trellaced, new benches have been installed, and the stone path was redirected and leveled.









As you can see, the garden now looks amazing! Thank you, Jack, for all of your hard work and planning, and that of your volunteers. Kudos!


