GREETINGS FROM FR. BILL

On the right is the prayer to the Holy Spirit from my homily last weekend. I encourage you to cut it out, take a picture or screenshot, or in some way save it to use repeatedly. Come, Holy Spirit!

Blessed be God on this feast day of our parish, the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity! Among the dogmas of Christian faith, this is the singular teaching that had to be revealed by God himself. And, indeed, Jesus made it clear that He and the Father are one (cf. John 10:30) and that he would send the Holy Spirit (cf. John 15:26). He made it even more clear when he commissioned his Apostles to “baptize in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit” (cf. Matt. 28:18-20).

This communion of three persons in one God is a great mystery. That doesn't mean we cannot know anything about God. We know much about God. The trick is, how can we participate in his love? One simple way is to imitate something of God's essence. That essence can be simply put in the famous writing of St. John: “God is love” (cf. 1 John 4:7). What are these three persons doing if they are all love? Simply loving, but in an abstraction. Their love is directed toward others, firstly the other two persons of the Blessed Trinity and then us. We are the targets of his love.

So, let's do the same. Let's target our love towards those whom God loves: our neighbors. Yes, even if sometimes they can be a pain in our sides. May today's Eucharist empower you to love as God loves! Happy feast day!

Blessings to Reese Davis and Zachary Mossman, who were baptized this weekend!

Come, Holy Spirit.

Come into my heart. Open my mind.

Clear away my distractions.

Renew my life. Renew my faith. Renew my passion. Renew my behavior.

Turn my pride into humility.

Change my anxiety into peace.

Change my sorrow to joy. Move my heart to love as you love.

Come, Holy Spirit.

Set my heart on fire for love of you.

Enkindle my desire for Christ.

Move my heart for needs of others.

Open my mind to your Scriptures.

Inspire me to serve others.

Come, Holy Spirit.

Sanctify me. Strengthen my will. Purify my conscience. Transform my mind.

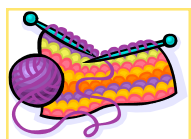
Come, Holy Spirit, and make me new.
