GREETINGS FROM FR. BILL

Since Fr. Anthony's first weekend here was right before the 4^{th} of July holiday, we wanted to wait until this weekend to do an "official" welcome for him. As is our tradition, there will be cake and ice cream after Saturday's Mass, and then cake and doughnuts after each Mass on Sunday. The cakes, of course, will be from the Basilica of St. Costco — yum!

Last Wednesday, our parish staff met off campus to review this past year of ministry and begin planning for the year ahead. Much of our reflections came from the guiding principles in the book <u>Rebuilt: Awakening the Faithful</u>, <u>Reaching the Lost</u>, and <u>Making Church Matter</u>, by Fr. Michael White and Tom Corcoran. In the initial reflection several years ago with Fr. Dave, the staff focused on hospitality, music, and preaching as the key points in making our liturgy more accessible and compelling. We renewed our commitment to these three aspects and explored various other items and ministry approaches to be included or refined for the coming year. These kinds of conversations always energize me, for they speak to the heart of why the Church exists. With that, there is much to look forward to in the fall and beyond!

We are saddened to note the passing of parishioner April Thompson. At the time of this writing, funeral services have not yet been scheduled. May her soul and the souls of all the faithful departed, rest in peace.
