## FOR WHAT IT'S WORTH: THOUGHTS ON FAITH

**First, remember the invitation I made to read and pray all 150 Psalms as a Summer Reading and Prayer Challenge?**

Here's another way you can get to know the Psalms in the way they work best, in the prayer of the Church. The Psalms fit into something called the *Liturgy of the Hours*. These *Hours* divide the day from beginning to end into moments of prayer, including daily Mass. Priests and religious pray this way, but laity like you and me are invited to pray this way, too.

The best free "app" (for your phone or tablet) for everything Catholic is called *Laudate*. It gives you all of the Hours to follow and pray, but it does give a note to download another app to view things in the "proper layout" and have more features/resources. That is called *Universalis*. While it is free on their website (<https://universalis.com/>) the app has a one-time price of \$9.99.

There are no additional fees of any kind, just one and done! It gives you a chance to try it out for free for a month as well. Once downloaded, you have everything you need on your phone (or device of choice) and have access to a robust prayer book 24/7! It has scripture readings, other prayers, Saint(s) of the day, the Angelus, the Rosary, and much more. It's an awesome resource to assist in daily prayer, and it doesn't require internet access.

You don't have to pray *everything*, but imagine having access to them all and figuring out how to make them a part of your daily prayer! Find what fits in your day. You will begin to develop a rhythm to your day guided by the prayer of the Church, and you will be praying it with millions of other Catholics around the world.

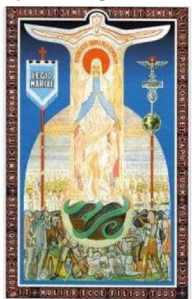

The Legion of Mary was founded in Dublin, Ireland on the 7th of September in 1921. It is a lay Catholic organization whose members are giving service to the Church on a voluntary basis in almost every country.

#### Legion of Mary's Aim

The object of the Legion of Mary is the Glory of God through the holiness of its members developed by prayer and active co-operation in Mary's and the Church's work.

#### Legion of Mary's Unit

The unit of the Legion of Mary is called a praesidium, which holds a weekly meeting, where prayer is intermingled with reports and discussion. Persons who wish to join the Legion must apply for membership in a praesidium.

#### Legion of Mary's Active Works

The Legion sees as its priority the spiritual and social welfare of everyone. The members participate in the life of the parish through visitation of families, the sick, both in their homes and in hospitals and through collaboration in every apostolate and missionary undertaking sponsored by the parish. The works are more of Spiritual Works of Mercy.

#### Legion of Mary's Active Membership

This membership is open to all faithfully practicing Catholics. Members attend weekly meetings (about an hour). They engage in prayers and active work. Candidates under 18 years of age can be received in Junior praesidia.

### KNOW #1: The Food Closet is going Green

Your Food Closet is moving to adopt greener practices in an effort to be better stewards of God's creation, cut costs, and enhance our customer experience. We've already slashed our paper-bag use in half – a future savings of \$648 per month. This line of effort includes no double-bagging, encouraging clients to bring reusable bags, and optimizing post-use cardboard boxes (like they do at Costco, putting your items in empty boxes when able/appropriate). We ensure all of the cardboard boxes we receive get broken down for recycling, which is estimated at 3-5 hundred pounds per week. Luanne, one of our great volunteers, recycles all of our plastic, while Ted and Mary recycle all our cans and bottles. Thank you, Green Team!

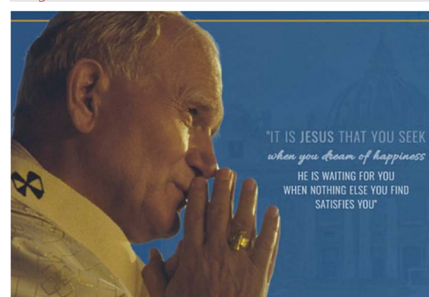
