

Legion of Mary's History

The Legion of Mary was founded in Dublin, Ireland on the 7th of September in 1921. It is a lay Catholic organization whose are giving service to the Church on a voluntary basis in almost every country.

Legion of Mary's Aim

The object of the Legion of Mary is the Glory of God through the holiness of its members developed by prayer and active co-operation in Mary's and the Church's work.

Legion of Mary's Unit

The unit of the Legion of Mary is called a praesidium, which holds a weekly meeting, where prayer is intermingled with reports and discussion. Persons who wish to join the Legion must apply for membership in a praesidium.

Legion of Mary's Active Works

The Legion sees as its priority the spiritual and social welfare of everyone. The members participate in the life of the parish through visitation of families, the sick, both in their homes and in hospitals and through collaboration in every apostolate and missionary undertaking sponsored by the parish. The works are more of Spiritual Works of Mercy.

Legion of Mary's Active Membership

This membership is open to all faithfully practicing Catholics. Members attend weekly meetings (about an hour). They engage in prayers and active work. Candidates under 18 years of age can be received in Junior praesidia.

KNOW #1: The Food Closet is going Green

Your Food Closet is moving to adopt greener practices in an effort to be better stewards of God's creation, cut costs, and enhance our customer experience. We've already slashed our paper-bag use in half — a future savings of \$648 per month. This line of effort includes no double-bagging, encouraging clients to bring reusable bags, and optimizing post-use cardboard boxes (like they do at Costco, putting your items in empty boxes when able/appropriate). We ensure all of the cardboard boxes we receive get broken down for recycling, which is estimated at 3–5 hundred pounds per week. Luanne, one of our great volunteers, recycles all of our plastic, while Ted and Mary recycle all our cans and bottles. Thank you, Green Team!
