GREETINGS FROM FR. BILL

Hello, everyone! Snickers and I returned earlier this week from a vacation down in southern Oregon. We left after the 11:15am Mass on the 14th. It was a little nerve-wracking, especially around Eugene and south of Cottage Grove, as there were many jack-knifed trucks with trailers in those areas. In fact, upon my return last Sunday, one of the rigs was *still* on the side of the road! They had workers emptying the trailer by hand prior to moving the rig out of the ditch. I missed the majority of our bad weather during the week; I hope you were all safe! I am glad to be back.

This weekend kicks off Catholic Schools Week (CSW)! We have students serving in various liturgical roles at all four Masses, and our Principal, Sarah Dummer, will say a few words at the end of each Mass as well. Our school is a vital and vibrant ministry of the parish, serving children in Pre-K through 8th grade, and I am inspired daily by the faith-filled dedication of our teachers and staff!

One CSW-related change of note for you all: our weekly **School Mass** (usually Wednesdays at 2:05pm)

will be held on **Thursday, February 1st at 11:05am**. As part of our CSW traditions, Thursday is our annual Grandparents & Special Friends Day and is a half-day for our students. All are still very welcome to join us!

Another special event happening this week: we will be hosting Archbishop Sample for our **Confirmation Mass** this **Saturday, February 3rd at 10:00am**. We have 81 young people and 12 adults who are preparing to receive this Sacrament. I want to invite you to come, even if you don't personally know anyone being confirmed. It is a wonderful celebration to be with our Archbishop and to support our families! We will be live streaming the Mass as well.

Because of this, however, we need to **cancel** our usual First Saturday Adoration, confession, and Mass in the earlier part of the morning. If you are participating in a novena of First Saturday Masses, the Confirmation Mass will still count!

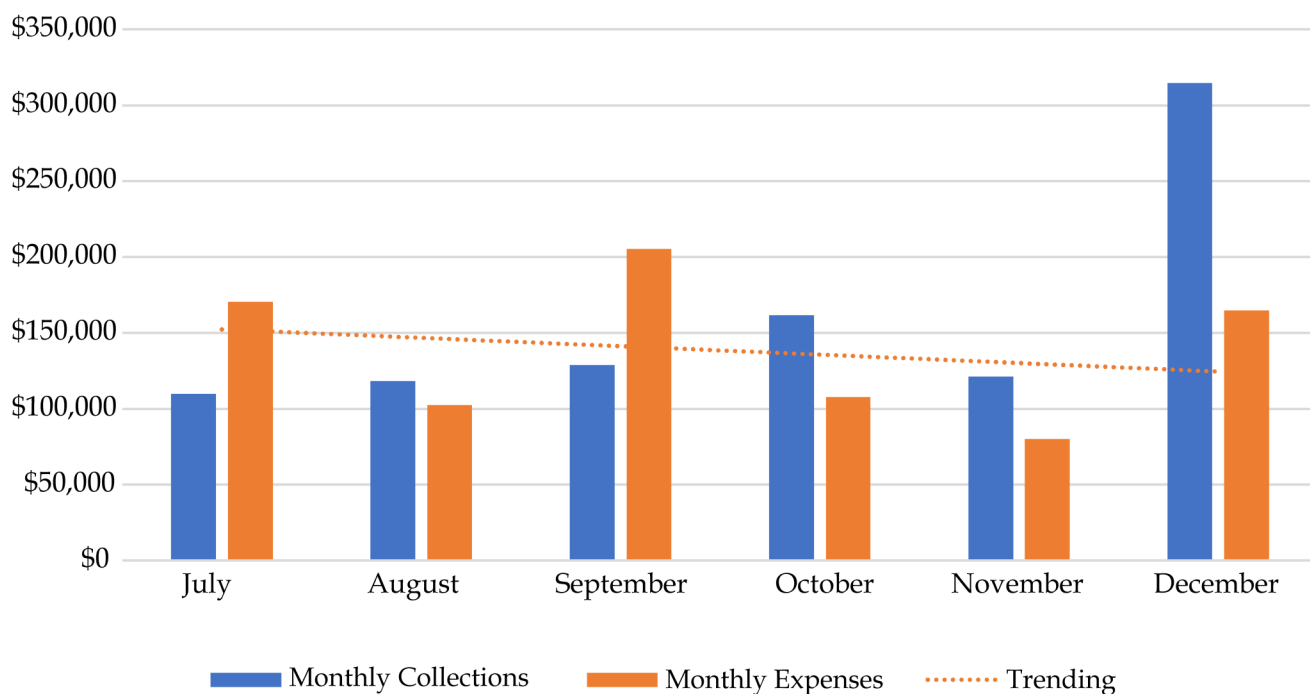

Morning Meeting

We begin the day with our schoolwide morning announcements, which includes a prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance. After, we learn about the calendar and days of the week, discuss the day's weather, and eagerly participate in Show and Tell.



Oral Language, Science, and Social Studies

Word Time with Squawker uses new words to develop oral language and vocabulary skills while encouraging students to express feelings, thoughts, and observations. We also build social/emotional skills such as feelings, play, self-regulation, and listening, while learning and practicing healthy social behaviors. Science and Social Studies lessons cover community, self-care, basic geography, plants, animals, and caring for the environment.



Art, Music, Spanish, P.E. & Religion

Each subject has a weekly focus and fun activity to complete.



Readiness & Writing

Using the Handwriting Without Tears program, we learn core readiness skills such as letter and number recognition, proper crayon/pencil grip, number and letter formation, and name writing.



Numbers & Math

Counting, comparisons, patterning, matching, and sorting are some of the math concepts we learn using music, manipulatives, and rhymes.



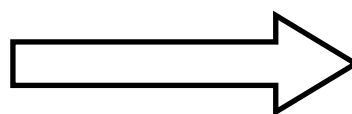
Language and Literacy

We sing, move, and use manipulatives to teach rhyming, clapping syllables, making and breaking compound words, and identify sounds. Books are read daily to foster a love for reading and build vocabulary.

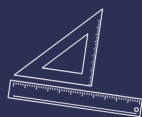

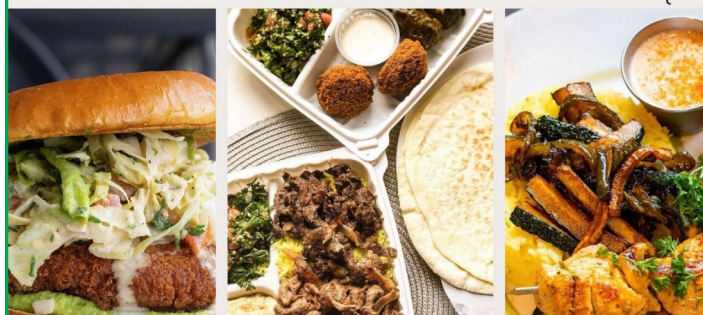

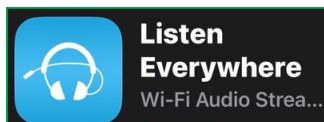

BRETT'S TWO CENTS

Hello, everyone. As part of our efforts to upgrade the sound system in the church, we've introduced a new hearing assist system. Yes, this means that those of you who have been using your hearing deficit as an excuse for falling asleep during the homilies will need to find a new excuse! Below is a brief explanation on how to access the system.

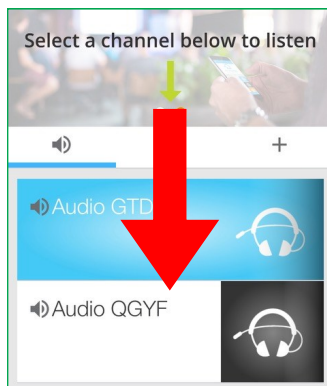
This system works in conjunction with your smartphone. Don't have a smartphone? We have two dedicated units in the sacristy that you're welcome to borrow — just remember to return them!

First, go to the app store on your phone and download the "Listen Everywhere" app. It looks like this:



Once you have the app, open the Wi-Fi settings in your phone. From the list of available networks, select the one titled **HT Hearing Assist**. If you don't see it listed, try walking towards the narthex, where the signal is strongest. Then, enter the password: **hthearassist**

Once you're on that network, open the **Listen Everywhere** app. After a moment, you should see a large blue dot with the words "Venue Scan" in the middle of it. Tap on this button. That should take you to a screen that looks like this:



Tap the lower box, labeled **Audio QGYF**, then make sure that the audio button at the bottom of the screen is lit up. Now you're ready to listen, either by:

- ✧ Plugging earphones/earbuds directly into your phone, just like you would to listen to music or a podcast
- ✧ Streaming the audio to a Bluetooth-enabled device (hearing aids, wireless earbuds, etc.) via your phone (just make sure the Bluetooth connection to your hearing device is active)

Voila! You've mastered a new technology! If you need assistance, any of the staff, including Frs. Anthony or Bill and myself, can help. Our Information Desk folks will also be learning about this new system in the coming weeks and be able to help as well. Please let us know your thoughts/give us feedback on the sound!
