This decision was many weeks in coming, and we've been in discernment with her about her situation. Thank you, Mrs. Dummer, for giving of yourself to the needs of our school!

As Mrs. Dummer now directs more of her time and attention to the things at home, I give praise to God that He has presented to us Dr. Anne Erwin! She is stepping out of retirement to help us in this time of transition. She comes with decades of experience as an administrator in the Hillsboro and Beaverton school districts. In addition, she has poured many hours into St. Matthew Catholic School which gives her a unique insight into our needs for our parochial school. She is a parishioner of Holy Trinity and has two grandchildren attending Holy Trinity School, and thus has personal investment in our school.

The first day that Dr. Erwin joined our school faculty, it became clear that she is just what we need at this time. Going forward, Mrs. Dummer will take on a new part-time position, that of "Assistant to the Principal," whereby she can tend to her commitments at home while also taking on administrative duties behind the scenes. This will allow Dr. Erwin to jump in and be with the teachers, students, and their families. Welcome aboard, Dr. Anne Erwin!

Soon, we will gather a search committee and put out an advertisement for a new Principal for the 2024-25 school year. Please keep all of this in prayer and specifically ask God to help us in our search, as well as for an openness to the candidate who will eventually be our new Principal.

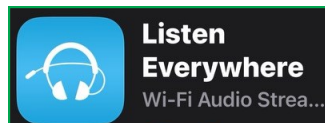


HOW TO ACCESS OUR NEW HEARING ASSIST SYSTEM

As part of our efforts to upgrade the sound system in the church, we've introduced a new hearing assist system, which Brett explained in his column last week. Below is a reprint of his brief explanation on accessing the system.

This system works in conjunction with your smartphone. Don't have a smartphone? We have two dedicated units in the sacristy that you're welcome to borrow – just remember to return them!

First, go to the app store on your phone and download the "Listen Everywhere" app. It looks like this:



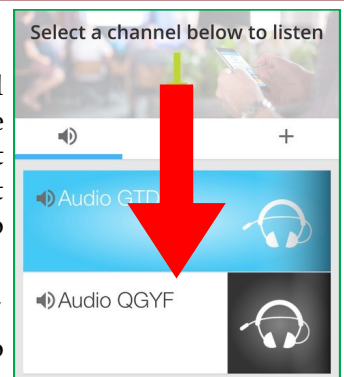
Once you have the app, open the Wi-Fi settings in your phone. From the list of available networks, select the one titled **HT Hearing Assist**. If you don't see it listed, try walking towards the narthex, where the signal is strongest. Then, enter the password: **hthearassist**

Once you're on that network, open the **Listen Everywhere** app. After a moment, you should see a large blue dot with the words "Venue Scan" in the middle of it. Tap on this button. That should take you to

a screen that looks like this:

Tap the lower box, labeled **Audio QGYF**, then make sure that the audio button at the bottom of the screen is lit up. Now you're ready to listen, either by:

- ✧ Plugging earphones/earbuds directly into your phone, just like you would to listen to music or a podcast
- ✧ Streaming the audio to a Bluetooth-enabled device (hearing aids, wireless earbuds, etc.) via your phone (just make sure the Bluetooth connection to your hearing device is active)



Voila! You've mastered a new technology! If you need assistance, any of the staff, including Frs. Anthony or Bill and Dcn. Brett, can help. Our Information Desk folks will also be learning about this new system in the coming weeks and be able to help as well. Please let us know your thoughts/give us feedback on the sound!

A NOTE FROM SARAH DUMMER

It is with a heavy heart that I let you all know that, after much consideration and prayer, I have made the difficult decision to step down from my role as Interim Principal at Holy Trinity to be able to better focus on the needs of my family. My father has been facing health challenges lately that require my attention and support. Additionally, my family is facing the challenge of the loss of childcare for our children. This has been an incredibly difficult decision for me and I am truly grateful for the support and understanding of the entire Holy Trinity community. I have enjoyed the time I have spent as Interim Principal here.

I am excited to say that we have found an Interim Principal to help finish out the school year: Dr. Anne Erwin. Dr. Erwin is kindly coming out of retirement from her 21 years in education, which includes four years as Vice Principal at Hillsboro High School, two years as Principal at North Eugene High School, and 10 years as the Principal at Beaverton High School.

Dr. Erwin is a parishioner of Holy Trinity and a grandmother to students at our school. She has also

been highly involved in both the Holy Trinity and St. Matthew communities. Her experience, combined with her devotion to the Catholic community, makes her the ideal person to take over as Interim Principal for the remainder of the school year.

Dr. Erwin and I will be working closely together as I step into a new role as Assistant to the Principal. I will be working mostly in the background to help with some of the administrative duties and to help provide continuity during this transition, but will still be part of the Holy Trinity community. Fr. Bill will soon begin the process to hire a permanent Principal.

I am confident that the dedicated staff and teachers at Holy Trinity will continue to provide the high-quality education and care that our students deserve. I believe in the resilience of our school community and I have no doubt that, with your continued support, Holy Trinity will thrive and grow in the future. I want to thank you for your understanding and support. It has been a privilege to serve as your Interim Principal and I am grateful for the time spent with each of you.
